-For the people of Haiti, that they would have adequate water, food and shelter

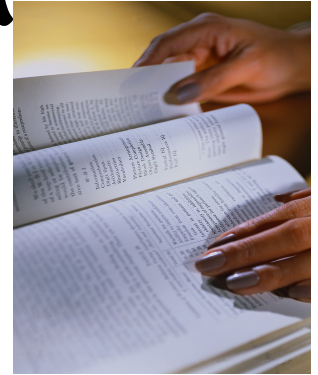
-For the church, that we would embrace our role as God's hands to the Haitians
